Calculator Requirements

- Students in Grade 7 and 8 require a "basic" calculator with: Square root key ()
- Students in Grade 9 require a "scientific" calculator with:

Square root key () , Integer key (+/-), Fraction key () , Exponent key (\wedge or x^y or y^x)

Note: Not all "scientific" calculators have these keys.

Recommended: TI-30XA or TI-30X by Texas Instruments, if available.
